

Chambers All In is an economic recovery initiative with Chambers across Illinois to help our businesses who continue to recover from COVID impacts.

Our advocacy work continues as we work with the GEDC to better prepare our community for the eventual closure of our nearby nuclear plants. In addition, we are working with several members to combat potential legislation that would devastate some of our local industries.
