# Shop Small Season has begun in Grundy County

The holidays are here which means its Shop Small Season and the Grundy County Chamber reminds you the perfect gift for everyone on your list can be found right here in Grundy County.

Throughout the county local retailers have already started their Holiday Open House events and Shop Small Season officially kicked off on Small Business Saturday, Nov. 27. Numerous events are happening through the county to encourage keeping your dollars local for the holidays.

"Our local business owners and their employees live and work here. When we invest in them by doing business locally, they reinvest in our communities," Grundy Chamber President & CEO Christina Van Yperen said. "Whatever you're looking for, shop small. If you're unsure where to find it, just ask a local business or reach out to the Chamber and we'll help you."

For every \$1 you spend in a small business, .67 cents stays in our local community. About .44 cents goes to the small business owner and employee wages and benefits, and .23 cents is reinvested in other local businesses. That \$1 creates an additional .50 cents of local economic impact, according to SCORE.

In order to drive shoppers to Shop Small this holiday season the Grundy County Chamber is hosting and supporting several events around the county.
